**Riverside Student Held After 2 Shot to Death**

VANCOUVER, Wash. (AP)—Police held a California college student yesterday after two persons were shot to death and ten others were gravely wounded. Officers booked John Frederick Anderson, 20, Riverside, Calif., on accusations of homicide. He and another man, Merford, were held in the Clark County jail in Vancouver without bail.

Dead were Mrs. Genevieve Jennings, 32, Vancouver, driver of a taxi, and Howard G. Moore, 40, Ridgefield, Wash., a barber, in critical condition in a Vancouver hospital was Dennis Charles Jones, 16, of nearby Battle Ground, Wash. Edgar Allen Wasser, 23, of La Center, Wash., was listed in serious condition.

In Riverside, Anderson's father, retired Air Force Major Billy L. Anderson, said: "He's never been in any serious trouble. He was a gentle, well-behaved boy. I'm biased, I suppose, but this is my assessment of him."

He added: "I have no idea of what might have happened. I certainly don't care to speculate. I'm in no emotional position to hazard a guess."

Police in Vancouver gave this account of Saturday's events: Mrs. Jennings was shot at the Pearson Airport where she had driven to pick up a fare. Her assistant took her to the cab. An hour later, cruising law enforcement officers saw the taxi near Battle Ground, about 10 miles from Vancouver.

The slender youth worked part-time at the Riverside Press-Enterprise from about last September to the first of last April as a darkroom technician and occasional photographer.

Employed under the newspaper's intern program for Riverside City College students, he had to report at 6:30 a.m. to open the darkroom and worked until 9:30 a.m. An associate recalls him as quiet and dependable.

"We hired him on the recommendation of the school," the associate said. "We had no problems with him."
