
I have been working on a different approach to the Z340 cipher using the "My name is Cipher" as the key. I've always felt like the 3/4 colored in circles felt deliberate in terms of how they were shaded.

In addition, there is old school wiring technology with timers which explains how to display the numbers 1-9 by using the number "8." What's interesting, is this technology correlates with letters that start at the top of the number 8 and work around clockwise. By using the my name is cipher as the potential key, we can make the below cipher keys.



So the first colored in circle that follows the letters A E N and Z sign will use the first cipher key.

The first colored in circle that follows the letter K will use the 2nd cipher key

The first colored in circle that follows the letters upside down T N A M will use the 3rd cipher key.

In addition to the above, the letters N and A are used twice and also pertain to the squares that follow N or A which would give us the below cipher keys.
